THE PENTECOST (FEAST OF WEEKS) (FEAST OF HARVEST) 1 day	Exodus 23:16; 34:22; Leviticus 23:16-22; Deuteronomy 16:9-12; Acts 1:1-47; 2:1; 20:16; 1 Corinthians 16:8; Exodus 23:14-19; 34:18-23; Deuteronomy 16:16-17.	This is a joyful time of giving thanks and presenting offerings for the new grain of the summer wheat harvest. This is a shadow of a greater thing to come; it all points to the final harvest of the righteous that will take place at the second coming of Christ. Christ is the first fruit of all, and all that are His will join Him at His second coming.	50 th day after the Passover	No servile work
THE MEMORIAL OF THE BLOWING OF TRUMPETS 1 day	Leviticus 23:24-25; Numbers 29:1-6; Psalm 8:13; Zephaniah 1:16; Revelation 1:10; 1 Corinthians 15:52; 1 Thessalonians 4:16-17; Matthew 24:29- 31.	 This is a reminder that the Most High God, through Christ, will one day set up His kingdom on this earth and it will happen by the blowing of frumpets. At the Last Trumpet (1 Cor. 15:52, 1 Thes. 4:16-17, Rev. 11:15-19), the kingdoms of men will come to an end and the kingdom of Christ begins. 	1st of the 7th Month	No Servile work
